

## CHOBE CHILWERO



Chobe Chilwero borders the Chobe National Park, which is the second largest national park in Botswana covering an area of 10,566 km<sup>2</sup>. Chilwero, means “place of high view” in the local language of Setswana. The lodge sits above the Chobe River and offers unparalleled panoramic views across the islands and flood plains as far as Namibia.

Chobe National Park covers a diversity of landscapes ranging from riverine forests to floodplains and periodic marshlands. The area is home to the largest concentration of elephants in Africa, as well as an abundance of hippo, buffalo, antelope and lion.



Chilwero, means “place of high view” in the local language of Setswana. The lodge sits above the Chobe River and offers unparalleled panoramic views across the islands and flood plains as far as Namibia. Chobe Chilwero has 15 bungalows, 6 king and 9 twin. Each bungalow measures 61 square metres and has its own en-suite bathroom



with a modern bath, indoor and outdoor showers, private garden with hammock, “sala” or private balcony, mosquito nets, ceiling fans, air-conditioning, hairdryer, minibar as well as an in-

room safe. The main public area includes a lounge and dining room, which are linked to outdoor viewing patios.
