The amenities at Crocodile Camp include a swimming pool, restaurant and bar area. The regular Sunday Braai (barbecue) attracts not only guests at Crocodile Camp, but also the residents of Maun. There is a campsite for those who enjoy life under canvas. It is well maintained and the trees and natural reed fencing provide a degree of privacy often lacking in public campsites.

Activities available from Crocodile Camp vary from day trips into the Okavango Delta, bird walks, scenic game flights, Horse riding and canoe hire (subject to water levels). In addition, Crocodile Camp Safaris operates safaris through the National Parks and has bush camps, Semetsi and Gomoti, based in wilderness areas of the Okavango Delta. eserve world famous.
