

CHIEFS CAMP



The camp is situated on the northwestern tip of Chief's Island, in what is termed seasonal delta. The area is therefore seasonally suffused with floodwaters. Generally, the floodwaters infiltrate the area in June / July and remain for a period of 4 to 5 months. The camp, constructed on a green-field site, comprises of 12 luxury bush pavilions, three with king beds and nine with twin beds. Each pavillion boasts a spacious seating area and private game viewing deck with hammock.

Apart from its predators, the area is also renowned for its large concentrations of plains-game, elephant and buffalo. Both white & black rhino were introduced in 2001 and 2003 respectively. Game drives are conducted in custom built open 4 X 4 vehicles, which offer individual seating. Game drives are conducted early morning and late afternoon or as otherwise requested (subject to availability). The accompanying professional guides are among the best in Botswana. Explore water safaris at the gentle pace of a poled mokoro (this excursion is offered in high season only, subject to water levels).

Each room is equipped with a hairdryer, ceiling fan, in-room safe, emergency Intercom and minibar. En-suite facilities include an indoor and outdoor shower.



The main lodge complex houses the dining area, bar, curio shop, library and reception area. This structure was built into the existing landscape, under a heavy canopy of mature Jackalberry, Sausage and Rain trees. The main deck area is split-level and offers expansive views over the floodplain to the north. The lower level of the deck houses the swimming pool. A range of spa treatments are offered in a new individual spa facility.
