

# Voi Wildlife Lodge



Nestled in the heart of elephant country, Voi Wildlife Lodge is located in the Savannah grasslands of Tsavo East, Kenya, just 5km off the main highway connecting the Capital Nairobi to Mombasa. Officially opened in 2003, the lodge is situated on a 25-acre site on the boundary of Tsavo East National Park, one of Kenya's largest game parks with spectacular views of nearby volcanic outcrops, such as the Kasigau, Sagalla and Mwakingali Hills. Designed to blend unassumingly into the surrounding environment, the lodge

boasts a natural waterhole often attracting big game, including elephant, lion, cheetah, buffalo as well as a rich variety of birdlife. The lodge is ideally placed for visitors wishing to combine a 'bush' and 'beach' safari holiday in Kenya with its accessibility to Tsavo National Park and its close proximity to the coast. With temperatures in the day average 25 degrees Celsius and cooler nights, Tsavo East offers an ideal climate in which to relax, indulge in the many facilities on offer at the lodge and enjoy one of the world's leading biodiversity strongholds.

Accommodating up to 300 guests, all rooms have spacious en-suite bathrooms and are furnished in African decor that is replicated throughout the lodge. The luxury rooms comprise two four-poster beds and views of the Savannah, which one can enjoy from the comfort of one's balcony or terrace.



During your stay at Voi Wildlife Lodge, you will have access to many facilities. The Tembo Restaurant is constructed using local 'makuti' thatch, and offers a unique dining experience with views across the plains of Tsavo East and the nearby waterhole. Bush breakfasts and packed lunches can be also arranged. The Safari Spa Bar and lounge offer a spectacular game-viewing platform both night and day. Designed on stilts overlooking the waterhole, the bar extends into the park allowing one to get as

close as possible to the sights and sounds of the African bush. The Mandhari Bar is adjacent to the Tembo Restaurant and provides an alternative setting in which to view game and enjoy a 'sun downer' before dinner. Relax and rejuvenate in the Safari Spa with its steam bath, sauna, jacuzzi, cold bath and five treatment rooms, all designed to cater for one's health and beauty needs. The Health Club comprises a fully-equipped gymnasium, complete with the latest fitness / training apparatus with an adjacent room designed for aerobics and yoga classes. The Chinmaya Conference Hall accommodates up to 250 persons, the conference hall is an ideal venue in which to hold a variety of corporate and private events. The Game Observation Terrace and Sundowner Bar are well-placed to hold corporate and private outdoor receptions. Also, the lodge offers a variety of activities for families, including a children's outdoor recreation area, swimming pool and jacuzzi, two badminton courts, a volleyball court as well as table tennis and a pool table. There is also a Discovery Area complete with a mini-library, TV and DVD facilities.
