

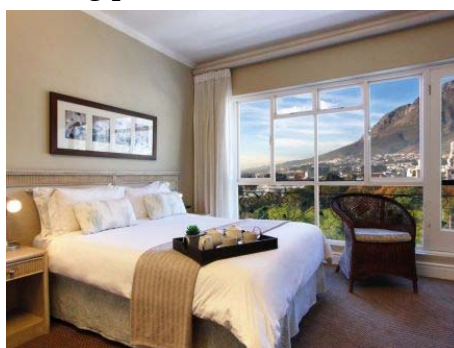
# Cape Town Hollow
