The St. James is located along the False Bay coastline overlooking the trendy and vibrant fishing village of Kalk Bay with magnificent views across False Bay and the Indian Ocean. The St. James is a grand seaside retreat, built and owned by mining magnates. It is over 100 years old, with wood paneling throughout that originated from an old shipwreck.
