

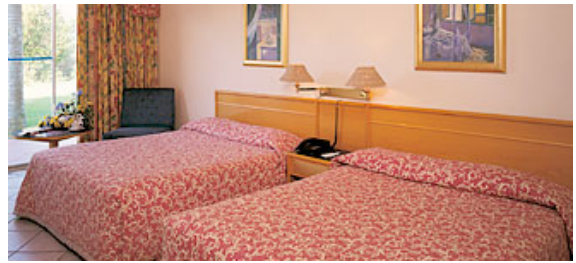
Ezulwini Sun
