

Lobo Wildlife Lodge



That is Lobo Wildlife Lodge; located in the North of Serengeti National Park, the most spectacular scenario of wildlife in its pure essence. It is a dream of romanticism in its remote location, strategically hidden inside an enormous volcanic rocky outcrop. It is the biggest Lodge on the migration route. You can watch and witness the migration by lying in the pool. The Lodge is artistically made of wood and glass elements around clusters of large boulders, harmoniously merging with its

surroundings; it also offers, from its raised location, stunning views of the most amazing natural spectacle to be seen on Earth. A waterhole below the Lodge attracts a variety of wild visitors during the day and is lit each evening revealing an interesting array of nocturnal animals, providing a close encounter with wildlife.

All the Lodge's 75 elegant and spacious guestrooms have superb views of the migratory route of over 2.5 million wildebeest in their desperate struggle for survival. Each room has a private balcony, and all of them offer stunning views over the vast plains of Serengeti National Park. Elegantly decorated in authentic traditional African style, the rooms are fully equipped with ensuite bathrooms, shower attachments and bathtub. King – size beds are provided with mosquito nets over the air vents. A third bed is available on request, as well as limited baby cots.



Lobo Wildlife Lodge offers from its romantic and remote location in the North of Serengeti National Park a unique action - packed safari adventure. Day wildlife watching, game driving photographic safaris, specialized wildebeest migration safaris, ornithological safaris, hot-air balloon safaris, and romantic picnics on the wilderness are many of the activities that any nature lover would enjoy. Also, the sumptuous swimming pool is situated on

the very edge of the rock, offering uninterrupted views of the horizon.
