

Mufindi Highland Lodge



Mufindi Highland Lodge is located in the heart of a series of tea plantations deep in the southern highlands amidst spectacular mountain scenery, in a private estate perched high on the edge of the Rift Valley escarpment. Surrounded by rainforest, dark thick montane forest and rugged bush interlaced with lakes, rivers and streams, the lodge offers guests some outstanding scenery. Although not on the usual 'tourist' route in Tanzania,

the Mufindi Highlands offer their own brand of magic and provide an ideal setting for relaxing with a good book or for burning off energy pursuing one of the many recreational activities on offer.

Mufindi Highland Lodge consists of 9 log cabins that. Each log chalet is designed for a family or couple (singles allowed as well), complete with en suite bathrooms. The use of local wood species for paneling and furniture is prevalent giving it a warm feel in the cool climate. Each chalet overlooks the lake and resident golf course and artfully decorated



There is nothing programmed during the stay at the lodge. This is purposeful as it is a location to unwind. Guests can choose from a variety of activities including fishing, hiking, horse riding, mountain biking trails, kayaking and canoeing, golf, bowls, badminton, or simply relax in front of a roaring fire. The southern highland area is a tranquil region where life is slow amidst the greenery of farms and tea estates. Not a

wild life location in the traditional sense, however guests can experience the stunning hills on horseback and hiking as you wind through farm roads. Meals are carefully prepared every day depending on the season and most ingredients come straight from the farm. Breakfast is typically continental while lunch is a buffet. Dinner- is a 3-course prix fixe in a fusion of African, Asian and European delicacies. The Mufindi estate is also a working farm, providing organic meat and vegetables for the lodge restaurant and Foxes Safaris' other camps in the region.
