


Two Rivers

Day 1 – 3: South Luangwa National Park

Arrive and transfer to the camp of your choice for accommodations.

South Luangwa is an unspoiled wilderness of tranquil rivers, ancient forests and open pans; this region offers excellent game viewing. Expect world class predator action, large herds of elephants, endemic species, and superb sightings of leopards, wild dog and lions. The collection of South Luangwa camps available offer an immersive, authentic experience that celebrates the wilderness and allows guests to reconnect with nature in a meaningful way. From wild luxury to natural elegance, these camps suit all types of travelers.

Day 4 – 7: Lower Zambezi National Park

This morning, transfer to the Lower Zambezi National Park and your next adventure.

The Lower Zambezi is flanked by the Zambezi Escarpment and the mighty Zambezi River. The forested valley of the Lower Zambezi is a haven for abundant birds and wildlife. The region is especially wonderful for large elephant herds, diverse birdlife and wild dog. With the stunning landscapes, this is a great region for photographers. Dotted along the forested river banks, Chongwe Safaris is famous for having the best views in the Lower Zambezi and elephants wandering through camp. The tents, suites, and private house offer the ideal retreat for all types of travelers. Read a book and take in the views, swim in the pool or stargaze around the campfire.

Day 8: Departure

This morning, transfer back to the airport for your departure flights home. You may also choose to extend your stay to a 10 night package (4 nights in South Luangwa and 6 nights in the Lower Zambezi).

South Luangwa Camp Options

Chinzombo: This wildly luxurious camp retains its bush authenticity with grass and canvas walls and spacious living areas that melt into the exquisitely tranquil riverside. Each of the six villas offers private plunge pools and panoramic views of the Luangwa River and its abundant wildlife.

Mchenja Camp: Flanked by a grove of towering ebony trees on one side and the Luangwa River on the other, Mchenja Camp offers luxury in the heart of the national park. Overlooking a wide river expanse, Mchenja is wonderful for watching large herds of elephants crossing the Luangwa.

Nsolo Camp: Nestled along the banks of the seasonal Luwi River, guests can watch the daily parade of wildlife from their private decks. With a design inspired by its intimate riverside setting, Nsolo welcomes guests into comfortable suites, which sit on wooden platforms and embody a cozy ambiance.

Luwi Camp: Nestled in a grove of ancient mahogany trees, the tented suites are designed to fully immerse guests into the bush experience. Set along the riverbed and overlooking the floodplains, guests can watch the abundant wildlife right from the privacy of their suite.

Kakuli Camp: Perched high above the Luangwa River, Kakuli Camp offers impressive vistas of the river's many visitors below. Designed to celebrate the panoramic scenery, a stay at Kakuli is a truly awe-inspiring experience.

Lower Zambezi Camp Options

Chongwe Camp: Dotted along the forested riverbanks, the camp is surrounded by wild beauty. Set at the confluence of the Chongwe and Zambezi Rivers against a beautiful mountainous backdrop, the camp offers the best views in the Lower Zambezi.

Chongwe Suites: Private and exclusive, these Suites offer sublime luxury and service against a beautifully wild setting. Nestled at the confluence of the Chongwe and Zambezi Rivers, the Cassia (1 room) and Albida (2 room) Suites are perfect for honeymooners or families and friends traveling together. Both have butler service, plunge pools overlooking the river and private dining options.

Chongwe House: This stunning two storey, four bedroom private house is set on a tranquil stretch of the Chongwe River against a beautiful mountainous backdrop. Throughout your stay, a dedicated staff and guiding team will ensure your experience is wonderfully relaxing and enjoyable.

- Meals from arrival in camp on day 1 to the end of the scheduled safari.
- Transportation by 4X4 specially designed safari vehicle, with qualified driver, for all journeys specified in the itinerary.
- Activities twice daily, Laundry, National park fees, Entrance fees where applicable, all sightseeing excursions specified.
- English Speaking tour guide
- Full Pre-departure and final documentation with detailed "Guide to Planning your African Safari".

Services Not Included:

- International airfare or airport taxes, quoted separately

- **Registration:** A 25% deposit of the total land price, per person is required. The remainder of the cost is due 75 days prior to departure date. Airline tickets must be purchased within two weeks of reservation confirmation.
- **Payment** is accepted by personal check, company check or credit card.
- **Reservation Policy:** All tariffs quoted include VAT and current grading levy. The price quoted is subject to change in the event of any unforeseen increases in fuel costs including currency fluctuations and/or Government levies/taxes, including Park Fees and Entrance fees. Safariline reserves the right to amend the quoted tariffs accordingly should the Government change the percentage level of VAT or introduce any other tax or Levy. Safariline will not cancel a tour, holiday or other travel arrangement once the client has paid in full unless it becomes necessary to do so as a result of hostilities, war or threat of war, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist unrest, active or threatened natural or nuclear disaster, fire or adverse weather conditions or if a group tour does not have a minimum required participants, or for any other adverse event beyond the control of Safariline. In the event of cancellation Safariline will inform the client without delay and will make every effort to offer a suitable and comparable alternative
- **Cancellations:** Cancellations received more than 75 days prior to departure will be subject to the nonrefundable \$500.00 per person fee plus any charged incurred by the hotels, ground handlers or operators up to the entire deposit of ,25% of the total trip costs
