

# Islands of Siankaba

*The Islands of Siankaba Lodge is the most classic of forested retreats. Siankaba's seven secluded chalets, each with its unique and individually different view of the mighty Zambezi River, are linked by a foot bridge to a haute cuisine restaurant. All of this is located on two untouched islands in the middle of the mighty Zambezi River situated between the 'Seventh Wonder of the Natural World', the magnificent Victoria Falls, and the world famous Chobe National Park.*



The Islands of Siankaba is a small and highly exclusive lodge, located on two Islands in the Zambezi River near Livingstone, Zambia. It is positioned just 30 miles upstream from Victoria Falls and 40 miles downstream from Chobe National Park in Botswana. It has been developed as a true retreat for discerning travelers who wish to distance themselves from the 'hustle and bustle' of the tourist activity in and around Victoria Falls, yet be close enough to explore the falls at their leisure.

One of the distinctive features of the lodge is how the excellence of its food and wines have developed a reputation for 'haute-cuisine in the bush' to compliment its first class service. The design and landscaping of all the facilities incorporates the use of natural materials that blend in with the feel of the surrounding bush and takes full advantage of the beauty of the riverine site.



Whether looking for a relaxing post safari treat or in search of one of the many adrenalin buzz adventures available in the area, Bunji Jumping, Abseiling, White Water Rafting, River Boarding, Jet Boating, Gorge Swinging, Elephant Back Safaris, Horse Back Trails and more. Also on offer is a host of other activities available from the lodge, including:

Guided birding and tree walks on the main island's nature trail, (bird species include: African Finfoot, Pels Fishing Owl, Pygmy Kingfisher, Rock Pratincole and White Backed-Night Heron).

Guided fishing trips for the elusive Zambezi Tiger Fish are available from March 1 to Nov 30, every year. Cultural Village Walks, a fantastic way to experience real Zambian culture and hospitality within a rural way of life are available. The excursion includes a tour of the lodges' local sponsorship school.
