View game at sunset on foot or from an open safari vehicle, as a professional armed game ranger and skilled Shangaan tracker, guide you along the spoor of Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Buffalo and Rhino. At dusk your personal game guard escorts you safely from your suite to the open air boma for pre-dinner drinks around a blazing log fire.



BOULDERS LODGE

Millions of years ago, subterranean lava flow created the great basalt dyke which transverses the Sabi Sand Reserve from north to south. Now, the only remains of this ancient geological feature are the rocky hills around Boulders Lodge.

Contemporary and airy, the Lodge at Boulders is inspired by the rough natural geometry of the rocks among which it is built. Overlooking the expanse of

the Sand River and the plains beyond, Boulders is furnished in simple luxury, using the natural materials which Africa provides in abundance. Hot clean air, the dark refreshing water of a private plunge pool, and space. Your suite at Boulders will provide you with a deep, relaxing calm and a silence that will strip away the distractions of the world, and leave you with a peace that will be yours long after you have left the bush. Light and spacious, completely private yet open to the view, each suite at Boulders presents a unique and contemporary view of luxurious African living.

EBONY LODGE

Ebony Lodge is set among the giant trees of its namesake, nine luxurious double suites on the banks of the Sand River offer air conditioning, double sided fireplace, cosy lounge area, bathroom and indoor and outdoor showers, a private swimming pool and secluded game viewing deck. The décor speaks of the art, culture and tradition of Africa and furnishings and finishes are soft, comforting and always inviting. In the jackalberry tree above the deck at Ebony, a flock of green pigeons are eating the sweet fruit. They crack the seeds in their beaks, and hang upside down, calling softly to each other like parrots. Disturbed, they flap off down the river, their wings flashing brilliant green and yellow in the afternoon sun. African colonial style at its most refined. From the cool and sumptuous folds of a leather sofa, you'll watch a giraffe browse on a distant acacia, or you yourself may browse from the extensive library in the quiet of the afternoon.
