

# MADAGASCAR East Coast Flora & Fauna



*Madagascar ~ exotic landscapes of rich verdant jungle, dry forest and thorny-bushes, surrounded by aqua blue seas. The ruins at Isalo, strongholds of jagged tsingy (or forest) of limestone masifs and a sanctuary of coral reefs and mangroves boarding 5000 kilometers of coastline. This island is a nature sanctuary sheltering endemic fauna and flora that live in harmony with the Malgasy people who are well known for their cultural richness. From butterflies to chameleons to lemurs to orchids, for birders and nature lovers an island delight!*

## East Coast Flora & Fauna 5 nights

### Day 1 Anatananarivo (Tana) / Perinet Reserve

Upon arrival you will be met by a driver and guide and driven to Perinet Reserve. The Perinet Special Reserve is a must for anyone interested in the flora and fauna of the eastern rainforest. The reserve (810 hectares) protects the largest of the lemur family, the Indri Indri. Perinet is also home to a large variety of chameleons, tenrecs, beautiful and varied insects and spiders, and lots of reptiles. It is also a good place for bird watching. Botanists too, will not be disappointed. Two nights at the ensuite bungalows at the Vakona Forest Lodge.

### Day 3 - 5 Perinet Reserve - Manamabato

Depart for the road trip to Manamabato. On arrival, met by a representative from The Palmarium Lodge and transfer along the Pangalanes Canals. The canals consist of a series of lakes linked by artificial canals, today mostly used by local fisherman. These fresh water lakes, offer visitors clear water for swimming and white sandy beaches for relaxation. Stay three nights at the Palmarium Lodge on a half board basis.

### Day 6 - Tamatave

Take the boat through the Pangalese Canals to Tamatave. On arrival at the port, met and transferred to the airport or extend you stay with the optional Sainte Marie extension.

### 4Night/5Day Extension to Sainte Marie

Fly to Sainte Marie. On arrival met and transferred to Princesse Bora. The four star **Princess Bora Lodge** offers discerning guests comfortable accommodation in a totally unspoilt environment. Enjoy all the beach and touring activities offered. Relax in bungalows with king-size beds, large bathrooms, fans and verandas which offer guests peace and privacy.
