

## Epic Botswana & Namibia

12 Nights /13 Days



*A unique and contrasting combination of two of the most beautiful countries in the world. Explore the wide open spaces of Namibia, taking in the awe-inspiring dunes of Sossusvlei and the Namib Desert, the stark beauty of Damaraland and the wildlife-rich area of Ongava Game Reserve. Then enter another world entirely: the waterways and lush green of Xigera in the Okavango Delta, the ephemeral Selinda Spillway linking the Delta and Linyanti, and the Linyanti area itself, famed for its prolific wildlife in a variety of vastly differing habitats.*

### ~Itinerary~

#### Days 1 & 2 : Kulala Wilderness Camp, Sossusvlei

From Windhoek, travel by vehicle to Kulala Wilderness Camp, enjoying awe-inspiring views of the mountains and the desert floor. Activities include nature walks and drives to scenic viewpoints in the private Kulala Wilderness Reserve.

#### Day 3 & 4 Hansa Hotel, Swakopmund

Travel by road north-west via the Kuiseb Canyon with its dark, craggy canyons and moon-like landscape of flat gravel plains. We arrive at the grand Hansa Hotel in Swakopmund in the late afternoon to explore this quaint town on foot.

#### Day 5 & 6: Damaraland Camp, Damaraland

Travel approximately 280km, partly up the legendary Skeleton Coast to the Cape Cross seal colony. From here we drive the back roads through the game productive Ugab riverbed, travelling north past the Brandberg Mountain to Damaraland Camp.

#### Day 6 & 7: Ongava Tented Camp,

#### Etosha National Park

We depart Damaraland Camp and drive into the Huab riverbed to search for desert-adapted elephants, before heading to Etosha National Park, where we experience the pinnacle of game viewing.

#### Day 8 & 9: Xigera Mokoro Trails, Okavango Delta

Travel through Okavango by mokoro, walking and camping out on a vegetated island - all essential elements of the Xigera Mokoro Trails experience.

#### Days 10 & 11: Ketumetse Trails Camp, North-eastern Okavango Delta

We depart this morning by aircraft to our superb Ketumetse Trails Camp, situated in an exclusive concession.

#### Days 12 & 13: Linyanti Discoverer Camp

We drive north eastwards to the private Linyanti Concession; arriving at our Discoverer camp, overlooking panoramic vistas of the Linyanti Swamps.

#### Day 14: Chobe River Boat Cruise, Chobe National Park and The River Club, Zambia

After a short morning drive and breakfast, we depart by light aircraft to the northern Chobe region of Chobe National Park. Enjoy lunch on a catamaran-style boat cruise as we leave Botswana and enter Zambia, arriving in the late afternoon at The River Club, in Livingstone.

#### Day 15: Guided tour of the Victoria Falls and transfer to Livingstone Airport:

Our epic Exploration meets a fitting end with a guided tour to the Victoria Falls, ending with a transfer to the airport.

These safaris combine Wilderness Safaris' permanent camps in pristine areas with private luxury trail camps that are erected prior to guest arrival.
