~Itinerary ~

Day 1 & 2: Nairobi – Rift Valley

Arrive Nairobi where you are met on arrival. Transfer by road through the scenically beautiful Great Rift Valley down to Loldia House, nestling on the shores of Lake Naivasha, a two hour drive. Enjoy a delicious lunch on the lawn overlooking Mt Longonot. Afternoon at leisure on the farm, with the option of a late afternoon horse ride or evening walk with Loldia's resident naturalist, or a boat ride on Lake Naivasha, witnessing the prolific variety of bird-life on the lake and the lakeshore. Take a Morning game drive around Lake Nakuru, famous for its abundance of flamingos and large variety of water birds. Lake Nakuru is also one of Kenya's Rhino Sanctuaries and large numbers of Rhinos are regularly seen, along with good sightings of Leopard. A full sit down lunch is served under the Acacia trees overlooking the lake. L/ D/ B

Day 3-5: Masai Mara

A late breakfast served on the lawns of Loldia House, with your choice of morning activities. Return to the lodge for a leisurely lunch prior to a 3:15pm flight from Loldia Airstrip direct to the Masai Mara Game Reserve. A short game drive enroute to the camp of your choice before enjoying Pre dinner drinks around the campfire, a four course candlelit dinner in the dining tent. Early morning game drive at dawn, returning to the Camp for a full hunters breakfast, served in the shade of the camps indigenous riverine forest. There are no set times at Governors' Camps. After breakfast there is the opportunity to take a game drive along the banks of the Mara River, to witness importance of this great river to the Mara's ecosystem. Afternoon game drives in the Mara widely considered to offer the best game viewing in Africa, and the evening game drive is duly rewarding for its famous Big Cats, wildlife and birds. Returning to camp before sundown. Memorable evenings around the camp fire and fine dining. B/L/D

Day 6: Nairobi / Departure

Morning game drives, breakfast and lunch before proceeding to the airstrip for afternoon departure for Nairobi. On arrival you are met at Wilson Airport and transferred to the Carnivore restaurant for dinner. (Payable direct) before final transfer to Airport for departure.

~Extension to Lake Victoria~

Day 6 – 8 Lake Victoria Mfangano Island Extension

Flight from the Masai Mara to Lake Victoria and Mfangano Island Camp. Set in beautiful gardens on a secluded island bay there are six double rooms, all offering spectacular views across the lake. Rooms are tastefully decorated in the Luo tribal style of thatch and clay. Each morning, fleets of brightly coloured fishing boats glide past, and each evening, as you dine on the freshest of catches, their lights shimmer across the water. Enjoy two nights/three days of fishing, water activities. B/L/D
