~Itinerary ~

Day 1 ARRIVE NAIROBI

Arrive Nairobi Late evening. Transfer to the Nairobi Serena Hotel.

Day 2 & 3: SAMBURU GAME RESERVE

Following breakfast, notice the change in the landscape as we drive north and see the various tribes and continue into the Samburu Game Reserve arriving at the *Samburu Intrepid Lodge*. All visitors under 12 join the Adventurers' Club offering a unique opportunity to explore some of the last great wilderness areas on Earth - in the company of some of its most hospitable and knowledgeable hosts. B/L/D

Day 4: SAMBURU /SWEETWATERS

Following breakfast, a short orientation by your driver/guides before traveling past pineapple plantations to *Sweetwater Tented Camp*. Take a game drive to search for elephant, giraffe, zebra, and the many animals which inhabit this private reserve. This evening perhaps an optional "night game drive". B/L/D

Day 5: SWEETWATERS/LAKE NAKURU

This morning drive west and south into the Rift Valley and Lake Nakuru, part of a chain of soda lakes. Arrive at *Sarova Lion Hill Lodge* and enjoy lunch as you sit on the plateau overlooking the lake. This afternoon game drive into the sanctuary searching for the rare black rhino, leopard, waterbuck, many bird species and possibly the Rothschild's giraffe. B/L/D

Day 6: LAKE NAKURU/GREAT RIFT VALLEY

Travel to the *Great Rift Valley Lodge*, perched on the dramatic shoulder of the Eburu Escarpment, overlooking the valley and Lake Naivasha. The lodge offers, horseback riding, bird walks, fishing and boasts one of the most spectacular golf courses in Africa.

Day 7,8 &9: GREAT RIFT VALLEY/MASAI MARA

The scene changes drastically from desert to vast plains into one of the greatest wildlife areas of the world as we travel to the Masai Mara, arriving for lunch at the Siana Springs Tented Camp. The Camp offers the latest in modern camping. Morning and late afternoon game drives reveal the large herds of buffalo

on the reserve, lion, cheetah, wildebeest, impala, giraffe, warthog, topi, cheetah, hyena and jackal. B/L/D

Day 9 : MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE / NAIROBI

Enjoy a final game drive this morning and return to Nairobi this afternoon, stopping along the way to do some shopping. Freshen up in your day room at the Nairobi Serena Hotel before proceeding to the airport for your international flight to London B/L
