~ Itinerary ~

Day 1 Arusha

Arrive Arusha and transfer to the hotel with the majestic mountains as background to glorious views. Overlooking Mt. Kilimanjaro, Kia Lodge offers 40 air-conditioned cottages under thatch. The swimming pool is behind the open bar on top of the hill with an outstanding 360 degree panoramic view of Mt. Kilimanjaro, Mount Meru, the Blue Mountains and the Maasai Plains.

Accommodation: Kia Lodge (D/B)

Day 2 & 3 Lake Manyara

Drive through densely forested hillsides to Lake Manyara National Park. This 123 square miles in area has a marvelous concentration of game, including 350 species of birds. A game drive through this Park takes you to flocks of flamingo on the soda lake which are a magnificent sight. Sightings of elephant, Zebra, hippo, as well as the curious tree-climbing lions.

Accommodation: Lake Manyara Tree Lodge B/L/D

Day 4 & 5 Ngorongoro Conservation Area

Transfer to the stunning Ngorongoro Crater Lodged perched on the rim of the ancient volcanic crater, one of the worlds wonders. The views from the top of the crater are breathtaking and 4 x 4 vehicles take you down onto the plain that shelters 20,000 animals; wildebeest, zebra, buffalo all who attract the big predators, black maned lions, leopard and hyena. The opulent lodge features antiques, African art and English country house furnishings. Suites are romantic and intimate with shimmering silks and polished woods.

Accommodation: Crater Lodge B/L/D

Day 6 & 7 Serengeti Plains

Our next stop by lite aircraft is the most famous wildlife sanctuary in the world, the Serengeti Plains. Here you will find the greatest concentration of plains game anywhere. Grumeti River Camp is situated on a bywater known for its huge crocodiles which lurk in its depths waiting for the great migration of wildebeest and zebra. Hippos wallow in the waters surrounding the camps tented luxury, complete with grand monumental beds made of Tanzania cypress.

Accommodation: Grumeti River Camp B/L/D

Day 8 Departure

Return by lite aircraft to Arusha for a light lunch and a day room before your return international flight or extension.
