~Itinerary~

Days 1, 2 & 3: The Luangwa Valley (B/L/D)

Travel by lite aircraft from Lusaka to the Luangwa Valley of Africa's last remaining true wilderness areas. On arrival meet local guide for transfer to the camp and the Luangwa Safari House. *Built on the edge of a seasonal lagoon visited by herds of elephants and giraffe who use this area to feed and water throughout the day, Luangwa House has a backdrop of the Chindeni Hills. This stunning private house has four unique bedrooms that will accommodate 8 guests (4 couples or families.)*



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For the next three days enjoy private guides and vehicles with an armed ranger for walks. Return to Luangwa house for dinner with your own private chef. **B/L/D**

Days 4 & 5: Lower Zambezi National Park (B/L/D)

Depart Luangwa by lite aircraft to the Lower Zambezi and Chongwe River House, built at the end of a massive winter-thorn grove on the banks of the peaceful Chongwe River, a tributary of the Zambezi. *On entering the house, the main room has low bridges over flowing water and the furniture has been carved from a single fallen winter-thorn tree.*



Here, you will enjoy your game drives in open four wheel drive vehicles, bush walks with your armed guide, night drives by spotlight, canoeing, fishing and river cruises. **B/L/D**

Days 6 & 7: Livingstone & the Great Victoria Falls (B/L/D)

Depart for Livingstone and the great Victoria Falls. On arrival transfer to Stanley Safari Lodge an exclusive oasis for overlooking the Victoria Falls which will take you back to the Africa of the 1920's. With only 10 private cottages receive an unmatched level of entirely personalized service. Bordering the Mosi-Oa-Tunya National Park, with a view over the spray of the Victoria Falls in the distance partake in all the activities available in the area from the lodge. **B/L/D**

Day 8: Departure

Following breakfast transfer to Livingstone Airport to depart.
