

# Discoverer Exploration Botswana with Wilderness Safaris

## The Great Wilderness Journey

10 Nights / 11 Days



*Experience a nostalgic, turn-of-the-century camping/lodge safari that recreates the sense of a pure game-viewing adventure reminiscent of the times of the great African explorers. At the turn of the century, explorers and adventurers made their way leisurely across the dusty paths of Africa, allowing the great continent to seep into their souls. Wilderness' guided mobile safaris takes time to experience and explore Botswana's contrasts and extremes: from the waterless and strange landscape of the Kalahari Desert to the lushly vegetated wetlands of the Okavango Delta.*

### Days 1, 2, & 3 Okavango Delta - Jacana Camp (Water)

Light aircraft flight from Maun to Jacana Camp. The Okavango Delta represents survival at the other extreme: abundant water, sunlight and soil combine to form a paradise bursting with life. We fly by light aircraft charter from the arid Kalahari Desert to lush Jacana Camp, situated in a permanently flooded region of the private Jao concession of the Okavango Delta.

### Days 4, 5 & 6: Ketumetse Trails Camp, Okavango

A unique adventure by mokoro, motor boat and land rover create an extended game experience as we transfer from the water world of Jacana Camp to the game-rich plains of Abu's concession. Activities concentrate on the open herd-filled plains surrounding "leche world," where the seasonal congregations of wildlife make the perfect setting for exclusive game drives, night drives and bush walks.

### Day 7, 8 & 9: Linyanti Trails Camp, Linyanti Concession

Fly by light aircraft to the private Linyanti Concession; arriving at our private Premier campsite overlooking panoramic vistas of the Linyanti Swamps. The landscape changes from the Okavango's floodplains to savannah habitat with sweeping views, creating a paradise for a high diversity of wildlife and bird species. Enjoy a full activity to the Savuti Channel, with lunch at a private hide overlooking a waterhole.

### Day 10 - Chobe National Park & Sussi Lodge, Zambia

After a short morning drive and breakfast, we depart by light aircraft to the northern Chobe region of Chobe National Park. This area is famous for its vast herds of elephants and other unique species such as the elusive puku and Chobe bushbuck that move to the river in the hottest hours of the day. Enjoy a boat cruise in a catamaran-style shaded boat.

### Day 11 : End of Safari

Enjoy a guided tour of the Falls then bid farewell as you transfer to the Livingstone airport for departure.
