

Adventurer Exploration Botswana with Wilderness Safaris



Migration Routes

9 Nights/10Days

Experience a nostalgic camping safari that recreates a sense of wildlife adventure reminiscent of the times of the early African explorers, taking you back to the bygone days of Africa's exploration. Adventurer camping aims to bring you closer to nature, with lively campfires, hurricane lanterns, diverse activities and a warm atmosphere permeating the camp's simple comforts and pristine wilderness!

Day 1: Chundukwa River Lodge, Zambia

After arrival in Livingstone you will be met by a representative and transferred directly for a guided tour of the Victoria Falls, then to Chundukwa. Situated on the grassy banks of the Zambezi River just upstream from the mighty Victoria Falls, the elevated open-fronted chalets boast stunning views of the Zambezi River, Chundu Island opposite and the Zambezi National park across the River. Located in a game-rich area sightings of hippo and elephant, among other animals are common.

Day 2 , 3 & 4: Chobe River Boat Cruise & Linyanti Adventurer Camp

After a full breakfast, leave Zambia and enter the Chobe National Park in Botswana. The Chobe National Park is famous for its vast herds of elephants and unique species such as the elusive puku and Chobe bushbuck that move to the river. Enjoy a light lunch served during the boat cruise on the catamaran-style shaded boat, after which we depart by road for the Linyanti region. The last part of the journey is more of a game drive as we approach the Linyanti, where our pre-erected Adventurer campsite is situated.

Days 5, 6& 7: Lechwe Island Camp, North-Eastern Okavango Delta

After breakfast, we drive to the airstrip and meet our light aircraft for the flight to Lechwe Camp. Activities concentrate around the bushy and wooded islands, open plains and the seasonally flooded channels surrounding the camp. Local populations of plains game allow for game drives by day and night. Experiences are magnified on nature walks, where the guide is able to delve into interesting topics such as tracking, medicinal (and traditional) uses of plants and a full array of smaller invertebrates and other species not usually noticed from a vehicle. Canoeing is also seasonally offered.

Day 8 & 9: Xigera Mokoro Trails, Okavango Delta

We fly by light aircraft flight to the water-filled paradise of the private Xigera area, within the Moremi Game Reserve, the ultimate Delta experience. Travel by mokoro to experience the serene waters and innumerable channels of the Okavango and its diverse plant and animal life. Activities include mokoro and walking safaris, which enable up-close encounters with the excellent diversity of birdlife (including Pel's Fishing Owl), frogs and a myriad of game species. Walking activities vary in length and duration through the seasons.

Day 10: Transfer to Maun Airport

Bid farewell to the adventure as we transfer by light aircraft to Maun Airport.
