

PAFURI WALKING TRAILS

Pafuri walking trail takes place in the spectacular Makuleke concession in the northern Kruger National Park. It is not only blessed with abundant game, but offers spectacular scenery, a sense of history and a true feeling of wilderness and remoteness as well as an authentic community partnership. This trail is led by an experienced armed guide and tracker. Accommodation is in walk-in dome tents ensuring that guests are intimately connected with the surrounding wilderness and feel, rather than just hear the sounds of the African night – from lions roaring, to porcupines rustling in the undergrowth. The site of the camp is different each night, walking from one location to the next and having the freedom to explore or to adjust routes dependent on local conditions. There is no better way to explore this magnificent area than on foot and experience first-hand the astounding diversity of Pafuri



Pafuri Walking Trails ~ Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Pafuri Camp

Arrive at Pafuri Camp to check in and meet your guide and tracker. Proceed partly by vehicle and partly on foot to the first night's camp.

Days 2 and 3: Travel to next camp

After a light breakfast, head off on foot to explore the surrounding area. The course of the day unfolds dependent on local conditions and sightings, but typically guests will spend the heat of the day in a shady location with a vantage point and continue in the afternoon to the site of their next overnight camp. Guests need only carry a comfortable day pack with them. Trails support staff shift the camp and guest luggage each day in time for the guests' arrival at the new site.



Day 4: Return to Pafuri

After an early breakfast, you depart on foot and return to Pafuri Camp.

We recommend spending a night in Pafuri Camp before or after the trail.

2009 Pafuri Walking Trails Includes:

- Accommodations in tented camps for three nights, on basis of groups no smaller than 2 for scheduled departures, no smaller than 6 for FIT departures, and no larger than 8.
- All meals, accommodation, taxes, services, local drinks, 14% VAT and the SATOUR Tourism Levy.
- Age limit no younger than 16. Participants over 65 require a certified medical certificate of full health.

Pafuri Camp

At the extreme north of the Kruger National park lies the ancestral home of the Makuleke people and the 24,000 hectare private Makuleke Concession between the Limpopo and Luvuvhu rivers. This is considered to be one of the most scenic areas of the Kruger National Park with legendary biodiversity and diverse game. Tented rooms with en-suite facilities look out over the Luvuvhu River. Relax on your deck in the remote wilderness, viewing waterbuck, buffalo, Elephant, Lion, Leopard, and incredibly prolific birdlife. Varied activities for every interest; game drives, night drives and walks are available.
